1. **Los Pastos Sauvignon Blanc** (Chile) 1 **£12.45**
Lovely, herbaceous, tropical fruit flavours with refreshing balancing acidity.
2. **Los Pastos Chardonnay** (Chile) 2 **£12.45**
Smooth and satisfying with ripe peach and pineapple flavours and a hint of creamy richness.
3. **Los Pastos Merlot** (Chile) B **£12.45**
Soft with succulent berry and damson flavours and a pleasing hint of cinnamon spice.

White Wines

4. **Cape 312 Chenin Blanc** (South Africa) 3 **£14.95**
Balanced, elegant, medium bodied wine with smooth fruit and soft refreshing acidity representing outstanding value.

5. **Elementos Torrontes** (Argentina) 2 **£15.45**
Fabulous rose and peach aromas while the palate is refreshingly zingy so leaving a lingering but voluptuous aftertaste.
6. **Redtree Chardonnay** (California) 2 **£16.45**
A wine with aromas of lime and kiwi fruit and just a touch of French oak. It has a balanced flavour of peach, pear and apple on the palate. A crisp fruity finish.
7. **Sauvignon de Touraine, Chéreau Carré** (Loire) 2 **£16.75**
Crisp, fruity Sauvignon with a clean, fresh flavour. Despite the euro exchange rate, this lively wine offers Sauvignon Blanc of real value.
8. **Terre al Lago Pinot Grigio** (Italy) 2 **£18.75**
A premium Pinot Grigio with a large helping of creamy, tropical fruits, spicy and aromatic in the mouth and a lively finish.
9. **Palliser Estate Sauvignon Blanc** (New Zealand) 1 **£23.95**
Top of the range Sauvignon in terms of quality and outstanding value. Concentrated Sauvignon flavours and a long finish are the hallmarks of a very well made wine indeed.
10. **Chablis, Domaine Christian Simon** (Burgundy) 1 **£24.95**
Chablis from a top quality winemaker which shows the unique qualities of freshness, finesse and depth of flavour.
11. **Babich Marlborough Black Label Sauvignon Blanc** (New Zealand) 1 **£22.95**
Classy Sauvignon from a long established family estate. Intense aromas and flavours showing ripe gooseberry fruit with a long, crisp finish.
12. **Sancerre Les Cailloux Blancs, Chéreau Carré** (Loire) 1 **£25.95**
Superb accompaniment to fish, chicken or Brie. Great depth of citrus fruit flavours, slightly aromatic in the mouth with balancing soft acidity.
13. **Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc** (New Zealand) 1 **£39.95**
Recent vintages have seen a welcome return to form for the iconic leader of New Zealand's wine industry. Pungent, concentrated gooseberry and newly cut grass aromas and flavours predominate with a long, lingering aftertaste.

14. **Pacific Heights Zinfandel Blush** (California) 3A **£14.45**
Stylishly packaged this is a popular medium style of Blush that is bursting with succulent strawberries and cream fruit flavours.

15. **The Landings Shiraz Cabernet** (Australia) B **£14.95**
The spicy Shiraz fruit blends perfectly with the bramble and blackcurrant concentration of the Cabernet.

16. **Los Espinos Merlot** (Chile) C **£14.95**
Black cherry and bramble scented with a smooth and weighty palate.

17. **Grant Burge Shiraz GB56** (Australia) D **£16.95**
Deep Shiraz colour with aromas of black pepper and spice. Flavours of both red and black fruits complemented by careful use of oak to give a long finish.
18. **Niel Joubert Pinotage** (South Africa) D **£17.95**
The signature red grape of South Africa. Tantalising aroma with intense colour and bold berry flavour. This wine is beautifully balanced with soft tannins.
19. **Casa Solera Bonarda Malbec** (Argentina) C **£14.95**
This blend of Argentina's two most popular red grape varieties produces a soft, spicy and rounded wine.
20. **Brindisi, Cantine due Palma** (Italy) C **£18.75**
A velvety smooth red from Puglia with ample body and fruit and a very soft, easy finish.
21. **Babich Gimblett Gravels Syrah** (New Zealand) C **£19.95**
A very small proportion of Viognier together with full bodied Syrah creates a wine with a warm, rich palate and lovely floral complexity.
22. **Casal Bordino Montepulciano d'Abruzzo** (Italy) C **£14.95**
Lovely, soft approachable fruit. Well made and well balanced wine with an easy drinking style.
23. **Coto de Imaz Rioja Reserva** (Spain) D **£28.45**
This is a classic Rioja Reserva. The use of new American oak gives complexity and structure and the integrated tannins give a perfect balance to the wine. Recent Silver Medal Winner at 2011 International Wine Challenge.
24. **Coto de Imaz Rioja Gran Reserva** (Spain) D **£31.95**
A truly great wine. There are only certain years that these top quality Tempranillo grapes mature enough to consider making the Gran Reserva. The grape must is frequently "pumped over" its lees to produce intense, concentrated flavours and then gain further complexity from a long ageing in new American oak. A wine in total harmony with all its constituent parts. Won Gold Medal at 2011 International Wine Challenge.
25. **Amarone Classico, Rocca Sveva** (Italy) E **£49.95**
The grapes are dried to increase fruit concentration and power. The result is then matured in barrel to produce an intense, rounded wine.

Sparkling Wines & Champagne

26. **Casa Gheller Prosecco Treviso** (Italy) 2 **£21.95**
Modern and fashionable, this Prosecco is clean, crisp and refreshing with a slight tang of green apples.
27. **Casa Gheller Rosato Frizzante** (Italy) 2 **£23.99**
Crisp and dry, this sparkling wine oozes a concentration of red berry fruits and a refreshing finish.
28. **Moet et Chandon Brut NV** 1 **£48.95**
Still the Champagne brand leader.
29. **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV** 1 **£54.95**
Famous for a long time for its consistent quality and full but biscuity finish.
30. **Laurent Perrier Rosé NV** 1A **£74.95**
The brand leader in Rosé Champagne. Bottled in its distinctive dumpy bottle and well enough made to repay being kept for a year or two.
31. **Joseph Perrier Cuvée Josephine 2002** 1 **£99.95**
The highest quality of the house of Joseph Perrier; elegance personified.
32. **Dom Perignon Vintage** 1 **£124.95**
Did this famous monk invent Champagne or not? Whatever, the champagne bearing his name is one of the region's best.
